Green Materials

nitrogen

Fruit & Veggie Scraps Spent Coffee Grounds Fresh Grass Clippings Cotton Fabric Egg Shells Tea Bag and Tea Leaves Cow Manure

Aim for a 30:1 carbon:nitrogen ratio in your compost.

Meat/Seafood Onions Pet Waste

Dairy Plastic lined paper products Manure from omni/carnivores

If you do compost citrus or onions, throw in crushed egg shells to help balance the pH.
